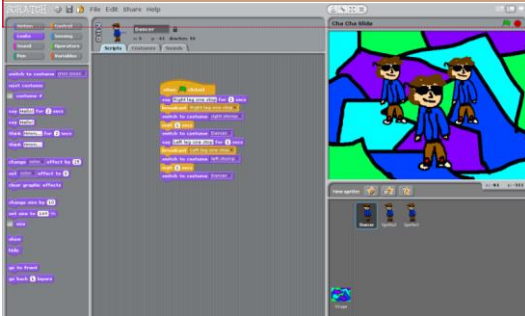


# EVALUATION
