Please note:

- ◆ Students should take courses in **either** the Academic pathway or the General Applied/Technical pathways.
- ◆ Students wishing to take a mixed programme will need to discuss this at their Information and Guidance interview.
- ◆ EPQ and Mathematical Studies may be taken by students following any pathway.
- ◆ Students should choose three or four courses each in a different option block. Students must have at least three Applied General/Technical courses or three A levels to take into Year 13.
- ◆ Students taking Physics **must** also take Maths.
- ◆ Students taking A levels in Economics, Psychology, Geography, Business Studies, Biology or Chemistry who **are not** taking Maths A level are encouraged to take Mathematical Studies as an additional programme.
