Staff will be available for socially distant appointments to offer information, advice and guidance on your options for University, apprenticeships and employment. There will be a ticketing system in place if you wish to speak to someone after you have collected your results.

Appeals process for results

Ofqual have issued specific guidance about how students can appeal the grade that they have been awarded due to the unique circumstances of the last two years. At the first stage of the process, students can only request that we check for an administrative or procedural error.
