Travel arrangements


- 1 executive coach will be leaving for London Stansted Airport

- Bags to be transferred straight from plane to coach








Passport, appropriate visas and an EHIC/GHIC are required





Be prepared for the journey



- On the go breakfast (avoid paying for an overpriced one at the airport)
- Drinks for the coach journey nothing fizzy or caffeinated. Be aware that you will not be able to take your drink beyond airport security
- Warm and comfortable layered clothing
- Device/personal entertainment no speakers allowed
- Passport and EHIC/GHIC to be given to your teacher



Items you will not be allowed to bring beyond security

- All drinks including water
- Semi-liquids like soup, jam, honey etc
- Cosmetics & toiletries creams, lotions, oils perfumes
- Sprays hairspray, shaving foam, deodorants
- Toothpaste
- Gels
- Contact lens solution



You can take these as long as the container holds no more than 100 ml.

They must be placed in a single, transparent, resealable plastic bag, which holds no more than 1 litre and measures about 20 cm x 20 cm.

You are allowed one plastic bag per person.

Luggage requirements



 Personal bag no bigger than 40 cm x 20 cm x 25 cm including the handle and pockets

 Checked Luggage: One piece not exceeding 10 kg

Top tip: bring only

- checked luggage
- a bag that can fit under the seat in front


