Year 7 Payment for Creative Curriculum

Dear Parent,

Our creative curriculum rotation exists so that, over the course of the year, students will study Art, Design and Technology, Food and Nutrition and Media. This will ensure that students have a breadth of experience across Key Stage 3, thus preparing them to make suitable choices at Key Stage 4. Students will rotate every half term.

An essential part of this provision is the production of a range of high-quality products and food dishes that the students not only enjoy making, but subsequently wish to take home. To avoid the need for students to bring money or ingredients at various stages each term, a single payment is requested for the academic year. A payment of £10.00 covers the cost of the project materials required to complete the Year 7 curriculum.

Food & Nutrition Ingredients

To avoid additional preparation for you, the Food team at Walton High orders ingredients required for the period your child will study Food and Nutrition. By doing this we ensure all students have all the materials they need for a good quality learning experience and as we purchase in large quantities you also get the best value for money. All you need to do is provide a container to take these products home. The dishes cooked will be part of a project broadening knowledge and skills relating to *Healthy Eating*.

Materials for Art and Product design

In order to offer the most exciting ADT Projects, the Curriculum Area needs a small payment towards the cost of materials used in products that students take home once completed. This payment allows us to purchase material of a higher quality than would otherwise be possible. The projects completed in Year 7 are: Masks with meanings, Stitch selfie, Portraits.

Your payment of £10.00 per student can be paid to Walton High via our WisePay system. The cost for students currently registered for free school meals, or who have been within the last six years, can be met from Pupil Premium Funding. If you believe you are eligible for this funding and wish to take advantage of it, please indicate on the reply slip below. Payments are requested from all other parents. If insufficient payments are received, projects become financially unviable and may have to be cancelled as Walton High is not in a position to subsidise the cost.

I do hope that you will enjoy seeing the results of your child's endeavours and possibly becoming involved in the projects as either a 'client' or 'user'. If you have already made this payment, please ignore this reminder.
